MRTA Informative & Protective Services (IPS) Committee Goals and Objectives 2023

MRTA Goal:

To positively advocate to elected officials, government entities, educational associations, and civic organizations for our public school retirement system and for public education so that all active and retired public school personnel will be secure economically, socially, and professionally in retirement and while working for our school districts.

Committee Goal:

To provide retired public school personnel with valuable information and to promote MRTA through media, such as local newspapers, Facebook, and other social media.

Objectives:

1. Every MRTA Region will have an IPS Committee Chair to communicate with and disseminate information to the Local Unit IPS Chairpersons.
2. MRTA Units will have an IPS Committee chairperson to disseminate information to active and retired public school personnel through newspapers, Facebook, and other sources of communication.
3. Committee members will use MRTA website, IPS page, Facebook, local newspapers, and other sources of information to:
 - a. Share information and reports at MRTA meetings.
 - b. Promote MRTA and its activities to increase membership.
 - c. Provide members and the public with information regarding retirement issues and activities.
 - d. Participate in October's National Cyber Security Month as a statewide IPS project.

Adopted October 5, 2022.
